## Top Tips for Completing the Waste Facility AR

- Log-in to the NWCPO.ie portal using your **Waste Facility** username & password sent by the NWCPO.
- When selecting your Waste Collectors make sure to include General Public and your collector permit if applicable.
- Include <u>all ELVs</u> (16 01 04\* and 06) that you accepted in (Waste In section) and sent out (Waste Out section). Use a separate line for each different permit that brought **ELVs In**. It's important your figure(s) for **ELVs In** include all ELVs received in that year, even if they did not all receive a CoD.
- If you have **used a conversion rate** to calculate tonnes or units, please provide this conversion rate in the comments box in the AR *Detailed Description of Waste/Comment* box.
- Assign the correct LoW/EWC code to your entries. If the waste code(s) is not on the relevant
  docket/invoice, you can find the full list of waste codes at the ELVES.ie link below.
- **ELV material should be identifiable** as such in the *Waste Out* section of your annual return. If it is not possible to label outgoing ELV metal under a 16-code, e.g a mixed source load or where a non-16-code appears on the collection docket, then please use the *Detailed Description/ comment box* to **provide the % ELV content** e.g this tonnage is 70% ELV material.
- If in doubt **confirm the destinations of loads** with the **collector/assumed destination site**. For example, if a company has more than one site, or if material may have gone directly to a Port.
- Ensure <u>all</u> **ATF Specific questions** (in the green boxes) are completed in the *Waste In, Out and Onsite* sections. M1 is a passenger car, N1 is a small van.
- Opening & Closing balances for ELVs/depollution materials should be entered into *Waste Onsite*.
- As is usual practice, if required Depollution Materials are <u>not</u> listed in Waste Out or Waste Onsite,
   ELVES will query what happened to your depollution materials in the reporting year.
- If you 'broker waste' (collect or arrange for waste to be delivered abroad or to a site that is not your own) complete the relevant question under the ATF Survey.
- Shredder Credits: As a Network ATF, if you sent ELVs/ELV material to a Shredder on the Island of Britain or to mainland Europe please inform ELVES of the accurate number/tonnage sent when asked so that it can be included in the ELVES group Shredder Credit application. The For ATFs page on the ELVES website includes the List of LoW/EWC Codes, AR Guidance & Video and the ELV Regulations which includes the ATF depollution requirements in Schedule 2: <a href="https://www.elves.ie/foratfs">www.elves.ie/foratfs</a>
